MONDAY MORNING LADIES LEAGUE RULES

2018 - 2019

- 1. The league will start bowling on Monday, September 10, 2018 and will bowl at Slocum's bowling center at 1675 Pennington Road Ewing, every Monday except those dates listed on the schedule. If it is necessary to cancel due to bad weather, and additional Monday may be scheduled.
- 2. *The last day of bowling will be Monday, April 29, 2019 as Position Round & Pins Over Average Day (P.O.A.), Those wishing to participate in POA will pay \$5.00 that day, since it is not collected in advance with the half season fee. All money collected will be paid out in prizes to those individuals who bowl total pins over average.
- 3. Roll Off & the Bowling Banquet will be Monday, May 6, 2019. There will be optional fun bowling prior to the banquet. This is not part of the regular season for League averages or for season prizes as individuals. In the event of a snow day, the schedule may need to be adjusted.
- 4. *The cost is \$12.00 week (\$8.00 bowling, \$4.00 banquet and prize list) and the League Secretary/Treasurer fee is \$200.00. Each bowler will be required to pay the for \$192.00 per half regardless of attendance.
- 5. REGULAR BOWLING WILL START PROMPTLY at 9:30 a.m.!!! Practice session begins at 9:20 a.m. Announcements will be made at 9:25 a.m. If a member is tardy, but arrives before the 4th frame is over, she will be allowed to make up the missed frames. If she arrives after the 5th frame has started, a blind score will be carried for that game. BE FAIR TO YOUR TEAM AND LEAGUE AND BE ON TIME!!!
- 6. The blind score will be ten (10) pins less than the average of the absent player. In figuring the handicap, the absent member's actual average is used.
- 7. There will be two (2) women on each team. In case of a one (1) woman team, the vacancy score will be 120. No sub is to be used in the Vacancy position.
- 8. The handicap will be computed at 90%.
- 9. There are a possible seven (7) points won or lost. Each team will receive 2 points for each game won and 1 point for total pins, for a possible total of 7 points.
- 10. The Secretary will post all team standings and bowling schedule and individual averages on the bulletin board weekly.

- 11. If a member cannot bowl, she has the option to pre-bowl or find a substitute. Pre-bowling must be done prior to the Monday that she is going to miss and must be done at Slocum's. If a substitute is gotten, there is no charge for the substitute, as long as the regular member is paid up-to-date. EITHER WAY THE TEAM CAPTAIN SHOUD BE NOTIFIED. The Team Captain is responsible for informing the Secretary of the pre-bowled score or substitute. Notation of PB (pre-bowl) must be clearly marked on the weekly score sheet if a member pre-bowls. You will only be able to use 3 pre-bowled weeks for each half. You must pre-bowl 3 games at a time and use all 3 games at the same time. You cannot use just on game at a time. If you need to leave early or you are going to be late you will have to take a blind for the one or two games. After that you will have to find a sub or take a blind for that week's games.
- 12. If a member is absent and does not pre-bowl or find a sub, she will be carried as a blind. She is responsible for the full weekly fee.
- 13. Perfect Attendance Certificate requires physical attendance on the scheduled bowling day; i.e. it does not include pre-bowling or obtaining a sub.
- 14. If a substitute bowls three (3) or more times, she is entitled to attend the banquet, but must pay the fee charged for the banquet.
- 15. If a member wishes to resign from the League, she must give 2 weeks notice to the Team Captain and Secretary. The member is responsible for the full fee for those two (2) weeks, unless a new member is found right away.
- 16. Refund will be made to any member who resigns for that amount of money paid in advance upon request.
- 17. If it is necessary that a game be postponed, the Team Captains should arrange to make up the date before the following Monday and inform the Secretary.
- 18. One member constitutes a legal team. The team may have:1) one sub and one pre-bowler, 2) one blind and one sub 3) one pre-bowler and one blind 4) one member and one pre-bowler, 5) one member and one blind or 6) one member and a sub. In the event of one sub and one blind, the blind MUST BE TAKEN for the member with the LOWEST AVERAGE, regardless of who was able to get the sub. NOTE: A VACANCY will be considered the one member if both regular members are absent, but there must be at least one sub there to bowl for the team or one of the regular members must have pre-bowled.
- 19. New averages will be established for all members from the first three games bowled.
- 20. Sub's average will be established from the first three games bowled. Use this average in handicapping these three games. Unless a Sub already bowls on a League at Slocum's, they will use the average that is on file with Slocum's from the other League they bowl on. If they bowl in more than one league take the highest average.

- 21. Subs will not be eligible for regular prizes.
- 22. To qualify for individual awards, a bowler must have completed at least two-thirds (64) of the scheduled 96 games.
- 23. No player will be eligible for more than one (1) individual award except for the most improved bowler award. In this case the individual who wins more than one award will be eligible to receive one of the following (High Average, High Series, High Single Game.)
- 24. Most improved bowler award will be based on the difference between the bowler's final average and the final average from the previous season. If a bowler does not have an average from the previous season, then it will be based on the difference between the bowler's final average and the average of her first 21 games of the current season.
- 25. Forfeited games must be paid in full by both teams.
- 26. Team Captain's duties include: Seeing that the team weekly dues are paid up-to-date and envelopes marked according to Treasurer's instructions (should be quite easy with our system of paying in advance for each half), Keeping score or designating a team member to do it (copy game totals from automatic scoring board for each person), checking the score sheets carefully, completing all totals down and across, and signing the score sheet. Also, please urge your team members to be ON TIME for bowling. Many people have other commitments and need to leave promptly.

ETIQUETTE REMINDERS:

- 1. Stay off wooden surface until it is your turn to bowl. Don't stand at the end of the alley nor prepare your ball until you are ready to begin our approach. This is because the bowler on the immediate right or left can be distracted by such movement, even though you think you are not being noticed.
- 2. Traditionally, the bowler on the right goes first. A possible exception is if the bowler on the left is throwing her second ball and is ready at the same time as the bowler on the right. Just use common sense. In all cases, the bowler who waits should step down and wait on the linoleum surface.
- 3. After throwing your ball step back immediately. Do not stand there waiting for the hit, especially if you throw a slow ball.
- 4. Remember to change into your street shoes (or use your shoe covers) if you go into the restroom.
